General Notes for Us

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Program Notes

Material: Program material varies by type of event.

For school assemblies, it is targeted towards grade level using our standard database or material that you provide. For Libraries and Family nights, it usually comes from our general database divided by ages — 4-8yrs old, 9-13 years old, 14-21 years old, 21-39 years old, and 40-65 years old.

If you would like to supply material, we ask that it is fed to us in an **Excel** or **Comma Saved Value** database, of which samples can be emailed to you are posted on our web site.

- **Interactive Trivia Blitz** uses regular and multiple choice questions.
- **All Play** requires multiple choice questions with between two and four answer possibilities.
- **Survey Says** needs subjective questions with up to six answers.
- **Versus** uses different words, numbers, and some basic trivia.
- **Big Picture Blast** requires animated Powerpoint Slides (or material for us to make the slides).

Stage Space: Generally, we like to be on the floor and not on risers. If a built in gym stage is available, we can use it for a video screen for games that require it.

- **Interactive Trivia Blitz** requires 24 feet wide X 12 feet deep of floor space.
- **Survey Says, Versus!** and **All Play** require at least 36 feet deep (50 feet for rear projection) X 30 feet wide of floor space.
- **Big Picture Blast** and **Category Busters** require at least 36 feet wide and 16 feet of depth (rear projection requires another 15 feet behind the stage area).
- **Triple Ballistic Bingo** can use about 24 feet wide and 15 feet deep in either direction (depending on front or rear projection). The audience should be able to sit at tables.

Power: We like to have at least TWO 20amp circuits (not just plugs) available for us to power lights, sound equipment, and game show podiums. If only one is available , we can cut as necessary and survive on one.
